Pastor's Message

When a person is baptized and received into our family of faith, we make promises to provide a community that demonstrates Jesus Christ's love for and value of all persons. We welcome them with words from our Baptismal Covenant (which can be found in The United Methodist Hymnal and The United Methodist Book of Worship). Consider prayerfully these words.

The pastor asks the congregation: "Will you nurture one another in the Christian faith and life and include these persons now before you in your care?"

The congregation answers: "With God's help we will proclaim the good news and live according to the example of Christ. We will surround these persons with a community of love and forgiveness, that they may grow in their service to others. We will pray for them, that they may be true disciples who walk in the way that leads to life."

Our commitment is to demonstrate the love of Christ in our life together. One of the ways we fulfill our pledge is to strive to create a sense of safety and well-being for everyone. This is what we mean when we use the phrase "safe sanctuary."

In the past few months, I have been working with the Staff-Parish Relations Committee and the Church Council to update Salem's Safe Sanctuary Policy. An expanded policy was adopted by our Council on September 27, 2023.

Let me share a quote from the document's purpose: "Our congregation's purpose for establishing this Safe Sanctuary Policy and accompanying procedures is to demonstrate our absolute and unwavering commitment to the physical safety and spiritual growth of all our community, especially children and youth." I would add to this statement that we are including vulnerable adults specifically in our policy. We have built on our commitment to providing the safest environment possible. Several of us have received more intensive training through Safe Gatherings. We have utilized the latest resources available to us and have begun implementing our updated policies. Volunteers who work with our children and youth have received expanded training and completed more comprehensive paperwork. In addition, we have discussed the policy with our youth and their parents.

We would like to invite you to learn more about our safe sanctuary policy. On Sunday, October 22 after the early service in the chapel and after the 10:45 a.m. service in the sanctuary, we will have congregational information sessions, where we will have copies of the policies and procedures available.


