The Alleluia's proclaiming our praise for the resurrection of Jesus Christ continue during this Easter Season. Our worship will focus on a theme of "*Celebrating New Life*." Here are the scriptures we will be exploring during this season:

- May 11: "Belonging to The Good Shepherd" John 10:7-11, 22-30, CEB (Mother's Day; Festival of the Christian Home)

- May 18: "New Things" 2 Corinthians 5:16-20, CEB Key verse: "If anyone is in Christ, that person is part of the new creation." 2 Corinthians 5:17, CEB

- June 8: Pentecost and Confirmation Sunday (Please wear red or orange to services)


I encourage you to read our scripture lessons each week. I have included our key verses to assist you with your focus in meditation and/or memorization.

Graduate Recognition >>>




